for a step for someone to get into my car, so it will be useful even after I am done with it.

When I got home from the hospital I decided that I really required to pay more attention to my food intake. So Dorian and I have been eating a lot of brown rice and fresh vegetables. I began a process of elimination to see what foods were causing my ankles to swell. I have had kidney challenges since childhood, but since my surgery in 2011 my ankles have gotten worse. I have found several foods and a few supplements that were contributing to the discomfort. I am finding that it is easy to let go of things that are not serving my body well. "Timing is everything". I am delighted with the changes and as soon as I get out of the cast I have some other ideas that I plan to implement. Dorian is becoming quite a cook and we are enjoying wonderfully simple and very good meals.

On July 17 the pins came out and my wrist began to get stronger every day. I got a brand new PURPLE cast. What a relief. The new cast was below the elbow and allowed me to move my fingers freely, the beginning of restoring muscle tone and flexibility. I was sitting in my chair at home, the morning of the doctor's appointment, when the feeling went over me "My wrist is normal again". It felt true.

My next visit to the doctor is August 7.

We have had a lot of rain for Wyoming (showers every day or two) this summer so the weather, though hot has not been unbearable. Since we live above 6,000 feet it is quite a bit cooler at our house than in town and we have central air.

NEW MOON

August 6

The Wheel of the Zodiac has brought us to the sign of Leo which is about love and our ability to create from the depth of our being. As we evolve the spark of that creation it shines brighter.

The horoscope is a soul chart that shows us what the script of our Soul is about—not so much who we are, but who we have come to be in the Revelation. We are not what we do or what we own or who we know, but something so far beyond that that the *boredom of daily life* will vanish in an instant as we reach beyond the limits of what we have believed. We can travel the world over, but the most exciting place anywhere is right inside of you. This New Moon shows us that the less we live from EGO and the more we honor the essence of our being the happier we become and the world that we create is a far more beautiful place for all to live in.

Jupiter shows us where we connect to our higher beingness and how. Jupiter's movement through Cancer brings the first of three exact oppositions to Pluto on August 7, just after the New Moon, and the first of three exact squares to Uranus on August 21. This holds us in an exceptionally dynamic cardinal T-square for most of August as well as bringing five grand crosses through next April. Jupiter's oppositions to Pluto in Capricorn reveal outmoded paradigms and the construct of the illusion which is collapsing to make a place for the new foundational shifts from the depths of our being. The squares to Uranus in Aries call forth revolutionary changes in every aspect of the human condition and calling us to "*KNOW THYSELF*" while acknowledging the Mastery of others as equals. Jupiter also makes a grand trine in water signs with Saturn in Scorpio and Neptune in Pisces which expands our depth of compassion and personal nobility, while pointing out that we are a part of the whole therefore we are involved in the whole even though we cannot see how in the moment.

There is strong feminine influence this month from the four archetypes—Vesta, Ceres, Juno and Pallas—with Vesta closest to the New Moon. Vesta comes from the Sanskrit word for "shining"; Greek mythology holds Vesta as the goddess of the hearth and keeper of the Eternal Flame, the "Light of Creation". She represents our divinity and devotion to our sacred task. This New Moon draws attention to our purpose and the necessity to honor our holy self. Ceres brings a recognition of what can fulfill us and therefore what we can

share with the world. Juno sits opposite this New Moon reflecting to us the requirement to forgive dominance and control and find it in our hearts to seek Oneness. Pallas brings us the wisdom as well as the warrior aspect of the goddess within us. She cojoins her mythic father Jupiter and opposes Pluto, offering empowerment to women and the divine feminine within men, as well as to assist us to see the world from a new perspective.

We are being called each month, through the acceleration of planetary influence, to realize that we are special and important to the overall scheme of where the planet is going. Just because the old ways no longer work, does not just mean endings, but a grand new beginning. Pluto closes old doors and grandly opens new ones. We are being brought to see without eyes what has always been with us.

FULL MOON August 20-21



(This is a picture of the Full Moon that occurred right after Prince George's birth)

When planets fall into the two earliest or two latest degrees of the sign they indicate either new beginnings or the end of a long established karmic pattern. On July 22 the Full Moon was at 1 degree of Aquarius. This Full Moon falls in the 29 degree of Aquarius testing our ability to hold ourselves sovereign while being of service to others. There must be a spiritual evolution to support us in all the mental, physical and emotional reforms.

What is going on “out there” cannot change unless we make deep internal shifts within ourselves. We cannot adapt those changes and stay as we have always been.

Jupiter made the first of three exact oppositions to Pluto just after the New Moon. It will make the first of three squares to Uranus at this Full Moon. This square intensifies the cosmic edict for courage, integrity and clarity. In these times the necessity for Truth and honesty are not just a good way to be, but a requirement. The noble side of Jupiter brings expansion, Faith and recognition of higher Truth. The shadow focuses on excess, arrogance and fanaticism. All squares indicate a change of direction and the squares that Jupiter will be making to Uranus between now and April of 2014 and seven squares of Uranus to Pluto, which are waxing squares, indicating a “crisis in action” where we must break free from the past. Jupiter forms the first of three exact grand trines to Chiron on August 21 expanding emotional awareness, intuition and new spiritual strength. Jupiter will be involved in five grand squares between now and next spring. A grand cross or grand square involves two oppositions and four squares; in cardinal sign (Aries, Cancer, Libra and Capricorn) this activates major changes in every area of life. All major relationships and interactions of life are subject to change. Remember change is not a bad thing.

On August 24-27 Venus in Libra joins Jupiter, Pluto and Uranus in a grand cross which will bring new clarity to our values and priorities, as well as, advocating peaceful approach to partnerships and unifying all interaction with others. From September 14-19, Mercury in Libra amps up the energy with the importance of saying what you mean and meaning what you say. On October 1-12 the Sun slips into the position vacated by Mercury and highlights what has been set into motion. On December 25, 2013 and again on January 8, 2014 Mars brings spice to the mix by making a grand cross with Jupiter, Pluto and Uranus and on April 21-24, 2014 the grand cross with Mars will be exact. These alignments tend to accelerate both personal and collective shifts in consciousness, altering our perceptions of reality and the rules by which we live.

This Full Moon spotlights Regulus, sitting in the heart of the Lion, Leo. Regulus has been said to be the most important of four Royal Stars, considered to be the sentinels guarding humanities evolution. Regulus is the Watcher of the North, closely associated with the Archangel Michael and the movement into heart-centered consciousness. This Full Moon’s conjunction of the Sun, Ceres, Mercury and Vesta in Leo brings us cosmic support for the blending of mind and soul. Our recognition of oneness with nature and the blending of spirit with matter are accentuated by this powerful gathering of aspects in the sign of the heart.

We are being called to boldly enter the temple of our own heart/Soul connection within and realize that as we forgot that we are creative Masters, we ceased to fully own our ability to live aligned as co-creator’s with God. How gently we can hold the All-ness as we remember that we are one with every single part of it.

CRYSTAL CORNER

AN OPENING FOR ENERGY

Hello and welcome to the month of August! This month is usually our hottest month here in Wyoming and it looks like that will hold true this year as well.

Things are heating up energetically, too. For the better part of a month, I felt totally out of control and disorientated. Then something shifted and I’ve felt more at ease and tranquil. I am also noticing when I fall back into old energy and react instead of act. It is truly a revelation of how easily we can do that.

This month I will continue with the Feng Shui (fung shway) theme, using the crystals and stones to promote the flow of energy. The front door to your home is the main access for energy to enter. (In our home, the entrance that we use the most

is at the rear of the house. This would not be our front door so keep that in mind when thinking of your own front door.) If anything causes a blockage of your main entrance, energy will not enter and circulate freely to create a balanced environment. It is very important that energy has a clear, even path of access to the main entrance of your home. It also needs space and time to begin the transition from outer world to inner. The energy that you need to affect the aspects of your life is about to cross your threshold and you can usher in positive rather than negative things. Your entrance is a message to the world about who you are, so set an intention about yourself and about what you want. If the approach to the world of your home is gentle and friendly, the energy you need will come to you.

Ideally, the front door and porch should be in proportion to the house itself. If the entry is too small, there might not be enough energy to circulate all the way through the house. Blessings and abundance could be stuck on your doorstep. If an entry is over-sized, there might be more energy than is appropriate and the space within would be overwhelmed.

Here is where the crystals come in. They can help regulate the flow of energy. Many Feng Shui practitioners use faceted sun catchers, many of which are leaded crystal.



These seem to work as well as a quartz crystal, but that would be your preference. A crystal hung near the outside of your front door will provide

protection against the rushing stream of energy entering the house as well as smooth the flow before it enters your home.

If your front door opens opposite a wall, that can inhibit energy from entering and circulating through your home. The energy that comes through the door encounters the wall and most of it will flow back out the door. To entice the energy in, hang a crystal above the door.

If your home has a long hallway that comes to a dead end, it is important to keep the area clear and well lit. Energy can get trapped at the end of such a hall, so the use of crystals will help maintain circulation. I use a mirror at the end of the hall to bounce the energy back into the home.



Another thing I might mention has to do with ceiling fans. As the blades spin, they will cut the energy in a room. If you would hang a crystal from the center of the fan, the integrity of the energy will be preserved.

The Fire Element Part 2—it's summer!!

Ahhhh Summer. What a wonderful beautiful time of year. Gardens are blooming, birds are teaching their young to fly and families are getting together for reunions. Connection and love is the Fire Element in action.

So how do we recognize some of the symptoms and behaviors when the Fire Element is in or out of balance? Let's start with the right side of Fire with the Heart and Small Intestine meridians.

The Heart Energy is about the sovereign, the king or queen of the person. The true you so to speak. The spirit of the shen, or life force, shines from the heart. Sometimes someone can have suppressed shen and can appear depressed. Lack of Fire of the heart can make the person feel sad, no energy, sleeping a lot, and depression. It's interesting that the opposite can happen that is called Heart Fire. This is heat that has built up in the meridian because of being depleted. Some of these symptoms are mania, insomnia, depression, bipolar disorder, and laughing or crying without cause. Building up the heart meridian or reducing the heat helps to balance the emotions of the heart.

The Small Intestine Energy is about separating the "pure from the impure". That might be emotions or information. The Small Intestine takes that information to the Heart so that it can act on it. When the Small Intestine out of balance it can show up as someone who tells inappropriate jokes, usually sexual in nature, at the wrong time, someone who when talking blurts

out something off the wall and others have a hard time understanding what they mean. Also the person might make quick “seat of the pants” decisions without thinking of the consequences of those decisions.

These usually are about affairs of the heart and these decisions are made over and over throughout the person’s life. Also digestive issues can come up.

On the other side of Fire are the Pericardium and Triple Heater Meridians. The Pericardium protects the Heart from the hurts of life. It is also the connection of one on one personal relationships. The Pericardium is like a castle gate that opens when it’s safe to let someone in and closes to protect oneself from hurt. Sometimes when a person is not prepared for a hurtful situation that hurt can go directly to the heart. So when a person has been hurt sometimes that person will shut people out and have a “hard heart”. Again there can be depression, anxiety, insomnia, heart palpitations and The Triple Heater is the connection with others “out there” in the world. As I stated in the last article, the Triple Heater is the “hostess with the mostest”. Someone might not want to be around other people and would rather be alone. Shyness comes to mind when thinking out of balance. The Triple Heater also is in charge of the waterways and passage ways of the body. This meridian opens up when it is needed, so sometimes swellings, edema, and other stuckness in the body.


There is so much to say about the Fire Element that this is just a small sampling of information. Remember to Love and give Love and your Fire will be balanced.


TAROT TALK

His Royal Highness George Alexander Louis Prince of Cambridge

Long live Prince George. This third in line heir to the throne of England was born just as the Sun was leaving Cancer at 29 degrees 29 minutes, so he joins his father, mother and grandmother Diana as well as Camilla in the sign of mother, family and emotional sensitivity. His Moon at 28 degrees Capricorn indicates that he will see the passing of a way of life that has been in place for centuries. His ascendant is in the 28th degree of Scorpio which speaks of charisma and secrecy. Scorpio ascendants are often said to have “It”—that illusive, attractive something a bit like the Mona Lisa smile. Pluto and the Moon are in the second house of self-worth and personal values. Pluto is in mutual reception with Saturn in Scorpio in the eleventh house. A mutual reception indicates that each planet rules the sign that the other planet is transiting. Saturn has been a strong representative of the patriarchal order as has

Capricorn. It is all about order and structure. Pluto puts an end to things that no longer serve us and as it firmly closes one door it opens others. The money and status of the royal family can very possibly change as the Prince grows up. This does not necessarily mean loss as much as a new perspective of greater equality. Pluto is the rising planet which means that it would be the first planet to cross the ascendant and rise toward the mid-heaven as the zodiac moves.

Pluto, Neptune and Uranus are all retrograde and indicate places where old karmic patterns require to be broken. Neptune is in the third house of communication and indicates an artistic flare in both speaking and writing. There also will be an ability to see things that others may not see as the intuition is quite strong. It is hoped that William and Kate will encourage his imagination and creativity.

Uranus lies in the fourth house of home and family. The nature of Uranus is change so the Prince may spend time in many different places as he grows up. In fact, he began his life traveling from London to Buckleberry and off to Kensington Palace to see the Queen on his second twenty-four hours on this planet. He also may feel as though he has more than one set of parents due to circumstances that develop in the family.

His Parts of Fortune is in Taurus, the Sun sign of his great grandmother the Queen. It falls in the sixth house, but only two degrees from the seventh house cusp which can bring a desire to see greater financial health for the populace. Taurus is the sign that deals with security and finances, as well as personal value. Taurus rules the throat and it is a point of interest that his great-great-grandfather George had issues with speaking.

The little Prince has four planets in Cancer in Scorpio's house, the eighth. Jupiter, Mars and Mercury are clustered together in the first half of the sign with Jupiter and Mars involved in a

grand trine with Saturn in Scorpio and Neptune in Pisces bringing the feminine side of his nature to the fore. Mars conjunct Mercury in Cancer can bring a temper that can smolder for quite a while and then erupt with the force of a pressure cooker blowing its lid, leaving everyone around reeling while one who exploded finds it difficult to understand why others are upset. After all, the explosion is past and the one with this configuration feels fine. The Sun, as we mentioned earlier is almost to Leo, lacking only one minute until the sign changed. An eighth house Sun can bring an interest in the spiritual, other than physical side of life as well as a strong sense the value of the things of the world.

Until we meet again in whatever manner that may be I remain your most humble servant. I AM the Lord St. Germain


