FULL MOON

August 28th brings a lunar eclipse in Pisces. The eclipse peaks at 4:35 a.m. MDT. Nineteen years ago on August 27th there was a lunar eclipse at 4 degrees 23’ of Pisces. What was happening in your life then? Have you responded to the call that was drawing you forward then? What is the most important desire in your life now?

Pisces keyword is Faith, while Virgo calls us to focus on the moment. Discernment is, perhaps, our most important tool in these times. This eclipse requires that these elements be attended to within self. Too

The Sabian symbols for this eclipse ask us to look beyond what we have believed we have seen for so long and graciously accept that there is so much more to life than just mundane, while we honor the part that everyday, mundane events play in life.

I feel the first step would be to recognize that we live in a state of illusion. What is really real? Who am I? Several of the stones come to mind to work with when you truly desire to understand yourself and your path in the divine order of things. This requires looking into the mystery of yourself and forgiving the illusions.

One of the basic stones I would begin with is Obsidian. Obsidian is the result of volcanic activity and occurs in several colors. 
