The year is half over and many things have changed here in Lander. We watch new little changes occurring all of the time. Even with the housing crunch Lander continues to build and people continue to move into town and buy homes. New businesses are springing up, also.

My trip to California was great. The intensive was powerful and those who attended spoke in glowing terms about their experience. I am looking forward to future trips to CA and connecting with more wonderful people there.

We have had a long, cool spring that is now ending and the heat of summer is with us. The tourists are passing through on their way to Yellowstone Park and Jackson Hole. The town is busy. There are concerts in the park. There is the annual July 4th street dance. There is hiking, camping and rock climbing in Sinks Canyon and Shoshoni National forest. The "Switchbacks" that go up to Frye Reservoir, Fiddler Lake and Louis Lake are busy. There is boating and swimming at Louis Lake. There is a magical fishing pond between Fiddler Lake and Louis Lake. The whole drive from Sinks Canyon Park to the main

highway above Louis Lake and back to Lander is about 80 miles. It makes a wonderful afternoon excursion.

Another beautiful drive which is much shorter and closer to town is Red Canyon Loop Road. This is a photographer's delight. It is about 13 miles of wild flowers, natural wildlife and amazing red cliffs. It is a great drive any time of year when the road is open. Generally, it is open from the end of May to late October.

We went up toward Shoshoni Lake which is where the water for Baldwin and Squaw Creeks as well as the Popo Ashi (sounds like Poposhia) river comes from. You cannot get to the lake except by four-wheeler or horseback, but the road is not too bad for a mile or two past the parking area, if you have four-wheel drive. The wild flowers are breath-taking and the land is so green and beautiful. Dorian has a new, professional camera that is so amazing. She is learning how to take pictures in all types of settings—night, day, time-lapse, slow-motion. We sent about three hours just enjoying the beauty. The air is so sweet that it just lifts your spirits to breathe it—talk about aroma therapy.

We are getting some smoke from the wild fires in California now. The air is somewhat hazy, which is not the normal state of our air. It truly makes me appreciate even more where we live when I go to large cities and see the pollution, as well as to feel how it affects the lungs.

There is a refinery in Riverton that creates inversions in the winter, from time to time. In cold weather we have wood smoke in the air, especially at night. However, generally the quality of our air is rather good.

As you may notice, I am fond of where I live and after having lived in the southwest, southeast and northwest I truly enjoy the experiences of Wyoming and the "Big Sky" country.

Many people ask if I am afraid of being house bound in the winter. The snow that we get is light and fluffy. Generally, we can sweep a path from our front door to our cars. We have no garage and have not yet had a problem starting the cars on cold winter days.

We get plenty of hot weather in the summer and even though we have a short growing season, the gardens flourish and there are plenty of vegetables and fruits. There is a farmers market all summer and many people take part in the community garden.

After experiencing choked freeways in large cities I appreciate the rush hour that lasts about thirty minutes during school and a little longer in the summer.

You can still drive down Main Street on a Sunday afternoon and there may be thirty cars parked here and there along the whole five miles of the town, most of them in front of the local movie theater. In the winter everyone is out skiing or home by the fire and in the summer, as soon as work is over on Friday, people head for the mountains. Personally, my idea of camping out is a nice motel, but it is still wonderful to have the option.

I have decided to issue an "I CAN" challenge to all of the wonderful people I know. This is a challenge to consider where you say "I can't" and change it to "I can" for thirty days. NEW MOON

THE CRYSTAL CORNER

Hello and blessings to all of you. It has finally turned hot in Wyoming after being very cool. We received a third of our annual moisture in May! It really was welcome, though, after about ten years of drought.

This month I will discuss the names of some of the rocks and minerals that are known by more than one name. It becomes a challenge to understand what someone is talking about if you know it by one name and another knows it by something else.

If I said to you that I had a beautiful piece of Pietersite that broadcasts tranquility and brings order out of chaos, you might ask me for the stone and already have in your possession a piece of Tempest Stone. They are one and the same. Tempest Stone might describe what it does very well but a mineralogist would look at you like you were crazy.

A wonderful formation of Merlinite might appeal much more to you than if I said I had a great piece of Psilomilane! There is something magikal about the name Merlinite that one might not feel for Psilomilane. And this stone is to assist in remembering the magik.

Some of the miners and finders of stones get trademarks to protect the names. I chuckle every time I pick up the Boji Stones. These are found in the middle of Kansas and the local people call them Kansas pop rocks. This is because they burst open when heated because of moisture inside. Boji Stones come with authentic certificates and the woman who controls the name will tell you she has activated them and any others will disintegrate because they haven’t been stabilized. The pair I have I bought at a roadside market and they haven’t disappeared yet! The thing is, if you want to market the stones as Boji Stones, a name everyone recognizes, you have to buy from her or her distributors or risk being sued for trademark infringement. I know this because they threatened me.

I happened to have the certificates but I could have sold Kansas pop rocks and not dealt with them at all.

Some retailers or promoters will buy a relatively inexpensive stone or crystal, give it an exotic name and market it that way. It does create a bit of confusion, though. So, if you can't find a stone by one name, do a little research and you might just find it masquerading as something else!

We, here in the U.S. can hardly fathom that a mere \$25 could make such a difference, but in other countries it can help a woman start a business. The food, water and education that the monthly gift to HUB provides are just the beginning. The assistance in getting a business started so that the people can become more self-sufficient is such a blessing.

In return for the monthly donation you have access to knowledgeable people who can give you guidance and direction for getting your own business moving in a more positive direction.
